Our “GPS” for Success (at a distance)

The following outlines our **GPS** (**G**uidelines, **P**olicies and **S**trategies) for **S.U.C.C.E.S.S.** as it pertains to distance learning. If we can all follow this GPS as long as we are distance learning, there is no end to what we can achieve!

**S-** Stay on mute unless asked by your instructor

**U-** Use the chat responsibly

**C-** Come prepared

**C-** Cooperate in rehearsal

**E-** Earn your wings

**S-** Stay focused on learning

**S-** Show respect

\*Distance learning will move slower than in-person instruction, and it will require great patience. Rehearsals will not look like typical in-person rehearsals, and I will often ask for students to play individually (going “down the line”). Please be sure to secure a quiet space for students to learn, and make sure they have what they need (such as a wire stand for their music and instrument accessories, etc.). Similarly, please assist your child with establishing a regular practice routine, arriving to their virtual classes on time and completing their Personal Practice Journals.
